## Year 5 Curriculum Newsletter

### Terms 3 and 4

Dear Parents/carers,

We hope you have had a lovely break over Christmas. This letter should inform you of everything we will be learning about in Year 5 over the next two terms.

#### **Our topic this term is: Victorian Railways**

We will be studying how the changes in the country occurred as a result of the age of steam. We will look at the impact of the railways on the people of that time and how this has developed since the 1800's. We will also look at the impact of Industrialisation. We will be learning how inventions were developed in answer to needs

#### **Literacy**

Literacy work in the first term will be based on the book *Street Child*, by Berlie Doherty. We will be considering choices and consequences for characters and the effect this has on the rest of the story. Over the course of the two terms we will be investigating Explanation Texts, Play scripts, Discussion texts and diary entries. Alongside this there will be weekly SPaG lessons.

#### **Maths**

We will be following the National Curriculum covering number, measure, shape and space.

#### **Science**

We are studying Forces and their effects.

#### **Computing**

In computing we will be developing skills in manipulating images on screen as well as writing and modifying simple programs.

#### **Other Subjects**

##### **P.E.**

We will be developing our skills in a range of sports this term including invasion games. During indoor P.E. we will be focusing on dance, gymnastics and team games.

##### **Music**

We shall continue to develop our listening, composing, appraising and performing skills by learning to play a range of tunes and composing our own compositions. We will compose Victorian street cries and learn a song about the Victorians too.

##### **Art:**

In art we will look at the designs of William Morris and use our observations in order to create our pattern in the same style.

##### **D/T:**

We will be using our creative and technical skills in the design and production of a cam toy.
